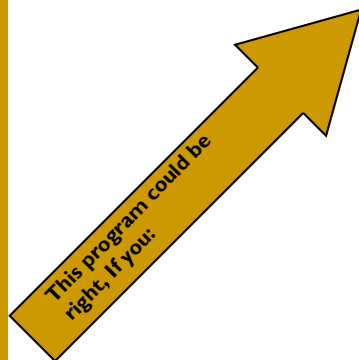

- ❑ Have a High School Diploma or GED
- ❑ Have a valid NJ driver's license/permit
- ❑ Are a resident of Essex, Hudson and Union Counties
- ❑ Are registered with the One-Stop Career Center
- ❑ Can pass a drug test
- ❑ Have a social security card and birth certificate
- ❑ Score at least 8th grade level on TABE Test
- ❑ Demonstrate a genuine interest in this field
