New Careers is a Newark-based, case management driven project to help men and women newly who are recently released from NJ state prisons obtain jobs and become productive members of their families and communities. Working closely with other program staff, the Employment Specialist will be central in facilitating positive employment, retention and wage progression outcomes for participants. This position requires existing working relationships in the Essex County business, nonprofit and public employer communities or a demonstrated ability to develop such contacts.

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PROGRAM ASSOCIATE: New Careers Project

As a pivotal member of the project team, the Program Assistant will provide administrative and logistical support to Case Managers and Employment Specialists at the program site. The Program Associate will also serve as project's frontline interface with participants, families and the community-at-large.

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
